CCEF Announces 1st round of Grants Technology, music and more

The Culver City Education Foundation granted funding for 11 CCUSD projects in the first of three grant application periods this school year. Funding totals \$13,731.95, and includes four projects for elementary school, one for the Middle School, and six for the High School.


