## CCEF Announces 4th Round of Grants

In our fourth and final round of grant applications for this school year, the Culver City Education Foundation funded 5 CCUSD projects: two projects for elementary schools, one for the middle school, and two for the high school. The funding total of \$13,612 included a generous \$1000 tech grant from the Exchange Club of Culver City and an unrestricted grant of \$2,500 from the Collins Foundation.

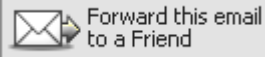
