Symantec Grants \$15,000 for Technology

Last year, the Culver City Education Foundation began a project to provide interactive whiteboards for every CCUSD 5th grade teacher. A collaborative grant with the Rotary Club of Culver City kicked off the project and now a generous grant of \$15,000 from Symantec will complete it. The use of interactive whiteboards will bring technology into all areas of the 5th grade curriculum. Color display and large size enables all students to see clearly, maintain focus and easily visualize abstract concepts.

Symantec has provided grant funds for CCUSD projects through the Culver City Education Foundation for math, science and technology for several years. Last year, all elementary teachers had a 3 ½ hour math professional development workshop thanks to Symantec. In previous years Symantec has provided funding for professional development in science, for the Science Lab at El Rincon, for the computer lab at Farragut and for an arts and technology project for all elementary teachers.
